Life Jacket Fitting

To determine proper fit:

- Buckle jacket snugly.
- Have child raise both arms straight overhead.
- Grasp the tops of the arm openings (shoulders of the life jacket) and gently pull up.
- Excess room above the arm openings and the life jacket riding up over the chin, face, or ears indicate the jacket is too big for the child.
- The life jacket is too big if there are more than three inches between the child's shoulders and the device.
