Teamwork is an essential component in the Fire Service, as it is in life. FIRE CAMP is a community outreach program provided to kids each year, by the Sacramento Metropolitan Fire District. FIRE CAMP has an extremely positive effect on the individual, family, neighborhood, school, and community levels. It is an once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to experience today's fire service, first hand. The program is designed to instill self-confidence, teamwork, teach life safety skills and provide a basic understanding of the firefighting profession, in a fun and exciting atmosphere.

During the 4 day-day camp experience, campers are grouped in "strike teams" of eight campers, and each strike team is mentored by two Metro Firefighters. Campers learn valuable life safety skills, while discovering what it means to be a firefighter.

The benefits of community outreach programs such as this one have both short and long-term impacts. FIRE CAMP may encourage a spark (no pun intended) in a camper to become a firefighter. If so, we have recruited for the future. Hopefully at the end of the day, the Camp will bring together an entire family around the participant's daily activities as mom and dad listen to the youth's narration of the day's events.
